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Executive Summary

1. Murphy Environmental Hollywood Ltd. (MEHL) operates a landfill for inert waste at its site at Hollywood Great, Nag's Head, Naul, Co. Dublin. The site is a former shale and limestone quarry. Restoring the site will serve to return it in line with pre-quarrying conditions and integrate it into the surrounding landscape.
2. The facility is licensed by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and operates under Waste Licence W0129-02. The licensee (MEHL) manages and operates the facility to ensure that the activities do not cause environmental pollution. MEHL is required to carry out bi-annual dust monitoring and submit all monitoring results to the EPA.
3. Dust monitoring measures the level of airborne dust in and around the site, which may be generated by landfill activities, traffic movements and other dust-generating activities around the site.
4. Dust deposition is monitored at four locations within or around the site on a bi-annual basis. Dust monitoring for Quarter 4, 2011 was conducted between the 18th November 2011 and the 16th December 2011.
5. Dust measured at Hollywood Landfill during Quarter 4, 2011 was significantly lower than the relevant limit value of 350 mg/m²/day at all of the four monitoring locations.
